Project Profile for Re-provision of Open Cycle Gas Turbines at Lamma Power Station

Green Power would like to draw your kind attention to our views about the above-captioned Project Profile.

- 1. Green Power opines that the project proponent should strictly execute statutory and its proposed environmental protection measures for the proposed project, even though the major works will be confined inside the existing Lamma Power Station area.
- 2. In particular, surface water run-off and drainage impact at the project site during the demolition phase should be well controlled. Major works shall be considered to temporarily be halted under rainstorm condition. Sewage generated from the project site, especially those collected from the temporary toilets, shall never be discharged directly to the marine area.
- 3. The project proponent should be responsible for ensuring that all the public fill and construction waste produced from the project will be properly stored, transported, and finally disposed of at the designated facilities and/or environmentally treated.
- 4. Emergency plan shall be in place in advance to cope with any environmental hazards (e.g. accidental leakage of sewage or fuels).
