Project Profile for Hudson Environmental Waste Disposal Centre (Waste Mineral Oil)

Green Power would like to draw your kind attention to our comments about the above-captioned Project Profile.

- 1. Although the project site is located at the highly developed industrial area, land contamination is still a potential impact whereas it is not mentioned in the Project Profile. We urge the project proponent to cover an impact assessment on land contamination and propose mitigation measures in the EIA process.
- 2. The project proponent should formulate emergency plan in case of any chemical/waste oil spillage during the operation phase.
- 3. Long-term monitoring of water quality in vicinity of project site, including seawater of seashore, stormwater runoff, effluent and water discharged from cooling system should be strictly implemented during the operation phase.
- 4. Since industrial exhaust emissions are anticipated in the operation phase, long-term monitoring of air quality in vicinity of the Project site and Air Sensitive Receivers, especially the concentration of volatile organic compounds and toxic air pollutants, should be implemented.
